We hope everyone has recovered from their Halloween festivities. We enjoyed seeing all the children in their costumes at our party—a great time was still had by all. Thank you for all the goodies contributed to our party. The children most definitely enjoyed finding them in the trick or treat bags they made and we enjoyed a few treats as well!

It's hard to believe November is already here. This month's theme is **"Sharing is Caring."** Our classroom is excited about **Falling Leaves, Turkeys, Pilgrims, and Native Americans.** We will also learn about **Election Day, Diwali, Transportation, Veteran's Day, Thanksgiving, Sharing** and **Hanukkah.** Additionally we will continue our lessons on shapes and begin learning our numbers and number patterns. Your child will bring home many things to share with you—crafts and art projects, number, science and language activities and lots of stories. Your interest in and appreciation of these special projects is extremely important in encouraging and stimulating your child's desire to learn.

Please check your child's class activity calendar for special days such as **Show-n-Tell** and our **Thanksgiving Feast** where the children will become Pilgrims & Native Americans in our version of the First Thanksgiving.

As the weather gets colder please make sure that your child is dressed appropriately for outdoor play—jeans or sweatpants and sneakers—and make sure all of their belongings are labeled with their names. Also don't forget to check the clothes in your child's shoebox to make sure summer clothes are swapped out for cold weather clothing.

A Few More Reminders:

- Some children are being dropped off earlier or picked up later than they are registered for, which may put us out of compliance with the staff/child ratio requirements. Please adhere to the schedule you registered your child for as we are staffed according to the number of children registered for early drop off and/or after school care. If you need longer hours, let us know so we can update your schedule and tuition rate, as well as adjust our staff/child ratio.
- Registration papers and information for 2022 Summer Camp and the 2022-2023 School year will be going home this week. Early registration will be held from November 8th – November 17th for all children returning in September. Registration for the public will begin November 17th so please take advantage of this opportunity to secure your spot for summer camp and all September sessions.

School Closures: School will be closed on Thursday, November 11th in observation of **Veteran's Day.** School will also be closed on Thursday, November 25th and Friday, November 26th for **Thanksgiving** and will reopen on Monday, November 29th.


