A Few More Reminders:

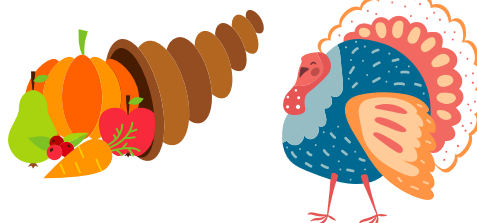
- School will be closed on **Friday, November 10th** in observation of **Veterans Day**.

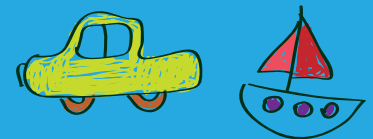


