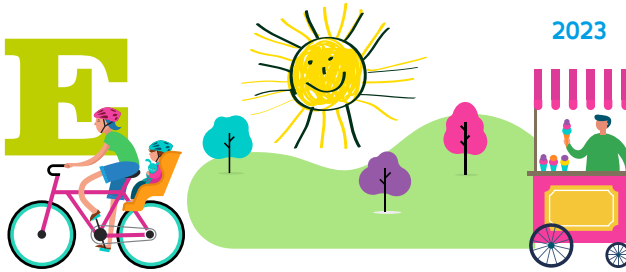


Discovering Me MONTHLY TIDBITS

Dear Parents,

Our graduation ceremony for our kindergarten bound children will be held on Friday, June 23rd at 5:30pm at Hommocks Middle School Auditorium. There is no limit to the number of guests that may attend the graduation. Everyone is invited to attend the ceremony, but only the children going to kindergarten in September will participate. The children have been working very hard to prepare and we are all looking forward to their big day.

A few details:

- All graduates should be at the auditorium at 5:15pm sharp.
- Hommocks Middle School is located at 130 Hommocks Road off of Boston Post Road/US 1. Look for colored balloons on the entrance door.
- Some rows of seats may be marked reserved. Please do not sit in these seats as we need them for the graduates.
- The auditorium is air conditioned and dress is casual.
- The \$75.00 graduation fee is due by Friday, June 9th.
- Thursday, June 22nd is our last day of school. All of your child's belongings must be taken home because we will be cleaning house and everything left behind will get put in the trash.
